




Light Rail

Light Rail doesn't run all night
Walk through the Airport parking lot following the signs to the light rail
Take the light rail to the Westlake Exit
This is Pine Between 4th and 5th
Walk up Pine to 6th, turn right
The Sheraton is 1 block ahead

Close by entertainment, shopping, nightlife and attractions


Easy access to hotels, restaurants and transportation

Finding the PASS Summit






Finding Registration

Registration is in 4C-3.





Registration Looks Like This...





Finding the 6th Floor


Most sessions are on the 6th floor

Take escalators directly from 4 to 6





Navigating the 6th Floor





The infamous "North Hall Rooms"

PASS is too big to just fit in the South Hall Very large rooms are in North Hall 2AB and 3AB To get there:


- →In South hall, go on 2nd or 3rd floor
- → Walk past the meeting rooms
- →Through the Hallway
- → Around the North escalators

Food

PASS breakfast is usually a little light

If you must there's a taco stand and subway in the convention center




